In 1998, two women with no formal background in education were moved by their faith in Christ to start a school where every student could receive an excellent education, regardless of their family's income. Today, Logos Academy, an independent school accredited by Middle States Association, serves over 275 students in grades K-12. Two-thirds of these students live at or near the federal poverty line. Without the aid of government funding, generous donors give scholarships to make it possible for students who normally would not be able to afford tuition at Logos Academy to attend at just a fraction of the price. Everybody pays something to attend. The results speak for themselves. Students from across the economic and cultural spectrum succeed at Logos Academy and go on to a meaningful future professionally, academically, and spiritually.






National Percentile for Logos Academy: 2016-2017

Exceeding National Average SAT Scores


Logos class of 2018 performed well compared to students across the nation.




Academic 'Achievement Gap' is closed at Logos
